### Rules/Guidelines:

- The Washington County Draft Horse Show is open to all Wisconsin residents; however, entries from Washington County and previous exhibitors will have barn space priority. Entries received from new exhibitors will be based on space available and date received. Exhibitors enter all divisions you may want to exhibit in. You can scratch but cannot add at the Fair.
- No ATV, utility vehicles, or golf carts are allowed on the premises.
- The number of entries may be limited.
- Only two premiums per entry number.
- There will be no additional entries after **June 10<sup>th</sup> or the day of the show**. Please double check all your entries to ensure that they are correct.

- Scratches will be allowed.
- Junior Drivers must be accompanied by an adult.
- Classes may be combined if there is an inadequate number of exhibitors entered.
- You cannot use the same horse in any other cart classes, except for in Junior Cart Classes.
- Two Copies of negative Coggins test is required for each horse.  
(Original must be shown; one copy to be kept in Fair Office).
- Tack stalls may be limited or unavailable depending upon the number of horses entered.
- All horses must be in place by 10:00 AM on Thursday.
- Draft Horses will be released at 5:00 PM on Sunday evening.
- Fees:
  - a. \$10.00 per slip stall
  - b. \$15.00 per box stall
  - c. \$20.00 per tack stall.

## Tiny Tots Showmanship Contest

The Tiny Tots Showmanship Contest will be held at the Washington County Fair Park on the Saturday of the County Fair after the Senior Showmanship Contest in the West Horse Arena. The contest is open to children 5-8 years old who are not yet enrolled in 4-H.

Children/Parents/Guardians will be required to arrange to use one of the horses that are already at the fairgrounds. Safety is important, so you are asked to use a horse that tends to behave well during the horse show. An adult is required to walk with the child and horse during the contest.

Children Will be divided into groups based on participation levels; Tiny Tots, Junior Showmanship, and Senior Showmanship, all at the discretion of the Draft Horse Superintendent. Children will be judged on their basic showmanship skills. The comments made by the judge will include tips on improving these skills. Ribbons will be awarded to all participants.



**ALL APPLICATIONS AND PERMISSION SLIPS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN JUNE 30<sup>TH</sup>.** Parents should come to the West Horse Arena for a mandatory meeting 30 minutes before the event start time.
