### Rules/Guidelines:

1. Please Note: If there is a category for an item, you must enter it in that category.  
Example: A Basket must be entered under the basket category (Division B) versus a category under Division A. Items entered incorrectly will be disqualified.
2. No duplication of items. The same item cannot be made twice and entered under separate categories.  
Example: A stuffed “doll” cannot be entered under “Handmade doll” and a second one made and entered under “Stuffed toy”.
3. All pictures (except stretched canvas art) must be framed and ready for display – Saw tooth or wire hanger for wall hanging or a frame with a leg stand. Stretched canvas art does not require a frame but DOES require either a saw tooth or wire hanger.
4. Only one entry is allowed per exhibitor per class number.
5. Do not use press & seal to cover items, use only clear wrap when covering is required.
6. Articles will be released on Sunday evening from 6:00 PM - 7:30 PM.

## Division A – Arts and Crafts

### Class No:

1. Oil painting.
2. Acrylic painting landscape.
3. Acrylic painting another object.
4. Watercolor painting – landscaping, flowers, scenery.
5. Watercolor painting – people, animals, any other object.
6. Pastel Painting.
7. Mixed Media (must be of at least two media – chalk, watercolor, ink), list what media was used on the back of the picture or on the back of the entry tag.

8. Graphite/pencil, pen & ink, charcoal drawing only, black and white.
9. Drawing in any other medium, list what media was used on the back of the picture or on the back of the entry tag.
10. Collage of various materials and/or subject matter.
11. Collage of photograph or same media.
12. China/glass painting.
13. Rosemaling.
14. Block printed, on the back of the entry tag describe both the article printed on and what type of item was used to make the block.
15. Macrame, other than jewelry.
16. Any metal article, other than jewelry.
17. Handmade home décor or furnishing, other than furniture.
18. Any other home décor not listed.
19. Ceramics, handmade.
20. Ceramics, pre-molded, seasonal item (Christmas, Easter, etc.).
21. Ceramics, pre-molded, any other item (1-2 pieces only).
22. Ceramics, pre-molded, sets/displays (3 or more pieces).
23. Mosaic article.
24. Jewelry, macrame.
25. Jewelry, metal.
26. Jewelry, leather.
27. Jewelry, beading.
28. Jewelry, any other (except something recycled).
29. Decorated garment of clothing.
30. Plastic needlepoint.
31. Mechanical art/item made from recycled materials, must list media used on back of entry tag and if item is operable.
32. Any art piece using recycled material, list what media was used on back of entry tag.
33. Any other fine art not listed\*.
34. Any other craft not listed – give description of how article was made (purchased frame and decorated versus made frame and decorated).
35. Handmade doll.
36. Stuffed toy.
37. Stamped greeting cards (3), mounted on board (envelopes optional).
38. Stamped greeting cards (3), made from recycled materials mounted on a board (envelopes optional).
39. Sketch Book – maximum size 8.5x11”; minimum of 8 pages.
40. Creative writing (short stories, poetry); minimum of 8 pages, maximum of 16 pages.
41. Genealogy (heritage poster or photo collage of 4-5 generations, and family trees).
42. Duct Tape Art.
43. Computer generated artwork, must list techniques used on entry tag.

Definitions:

- “Art” is tailored for functionality, or the design meets practical purpose and is used for something.
- “Fine Art” is solely for aesthetic, visual purposes.

## Division B – Basketry

Class No:

1. Basket, 5” or under with sides (no dimension can exceed 5”).
2. Basket, 5” or over with sides.
3. Basket, with cover.
4. Basket, decorative with handle (not a “hanger”).
5. Basket to hang on wall or door (hanger type handle may be used).
6. Shallow fruit basket.
7. Hot pad or table mat.
8. Basket – Seasonal/Holiday (Christmas, Easter, St. Patrick’s, etc.).
9. Any other basketry article not listed above.

## Division C – Scrapbooking

Class No:

1. Scrapbook – Birthday.
2. Scrapbook – Family Subject.
3. Scrapbook – Vacation/Travel.
4. Scrapbook – Any other subject.
5. Scrapbook Page – Anniversary or Wedding.
6. Scrapbook Page – Child’s Birthday.
7. Scrapbook Page – Adult Birthday.
8. Scrapbook Page – Holiday Party.
9. Scrapbook Page – Sporting Event.
10. Scrapbook Page – Any other activity/event (identify on tag).

Division Rules:

1. Minimum of 10 double sided pages and maximum of 25 double sided pages for each scrapbook.
2. All books and pages must be created within the last 12 months.
