### Rules/Guidelines:

1. Exhibit items must be picked up on Sunday between 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM
2. No person may have more than one entry in any class number.
3. Entries are judged on design, yarn use, and workmanship.

## Division A – Knitting

### Class No:

1. Hat and mitten/scarf set – adult (2 articles).
2. Hat and mitten/scarf set – child.
3. Scarf & Glove or mitten set – adult.
4. Scarf & Glove or mitten set – child.
5. Mitten Pair.
6. Scarf.
7. Cowl collar scarf.
8. Hat.
9. Slippers/Socks.
10. Baby bonnet and booties.
11. Afghan, baby or lap robe.
12. Any other small article under 12" (dishcloth, toy, etc.).
13. Scarf, hat, mittens, or glove set (3 articles).
14. Any other medium article over 12" (placemat, doily, etc.).
15. Any other large article (tablecloth or bedspread) over 12 inches.
16. Sweater/vest – child or adult.

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17. Baby sweater set w/bonnet and/or booties (or any other set).
18. Afghan one piece – full size.
19. Afghan using scraps – full size.
20. Afghan using appliques – full size.
21. Anything knitted for Christmas decorations.
22. Shawl/Hap English.
23. Any garment made with knitting machine.
24. Any felted article.

Division Rules:

Pin together pieces if more than one piece.

## Division B – Crocheting

Class No:

1. Hat and mitten/scarf set – adult.
2. Hat and mitten/scarf set – child.
3. Scarf.
4. Hat.
5. Mittens – pair.
6. Slippers/Socks.
7. Baby bonnet and booties.
8. Afghan, baby or lap robe.
9. Doll outfit.
10. Toy:
  - a. Baby
  - b. Youth.
11. Anything crocheted for Christmas decorations.
12. Any medium, crocheted article other than garment, over 12”.
13. Any small, crocheted article other than garment, under 12”.
14. Doily (mounted & covered).
15. Crocheted pillow.
16. Crocheted ornament.
17. Coat, Sweater/Vest – adult or child.
18. Baby sweater set w/bonnet and/or booties.
19. Afghan one piece – full size (no seams).
20. Afghan using scraps – full size.
21. Afghan with seams (e.g. granny squares) – full size.
22. Any other large afghan.

Division Rules:

Pin together pieces if more than one piece.

## Division C – Classes offered to youth 18 or under

### Class No:

1. Any knitted article made by youth 18 or under.
2. Any crocheted article made by youth 18 or under.

## Division D – Knitting & Crocheting Combined

### Class No:

1. Any Afghan.
2. Any other item.

## Division E – Wool Spinning

### Class No:

1. Sheep, 100% (Sock/fingering, 18-20 WPI "OR" Sport/Baby, 15-18 WPI).
2. Sheep, 100% (DH/Light Worsted, 12-15 WPI "OR" Worsted/Aran, 10-12 WPI).
3. Llama "OR" Alpaca, 100% (Sock/Fingering, 18-20 WPI "OR" Sport/Baby, 15-18 WPI).
4. Llama "OR" Alpaca, 100% (DK/Light Worsted, 12-15 WPI "OR" Worsted/Aran 10-12 WPI).
5. Other Fiber, 100%: Dog, Camel, Goat, Angora, Yak, Cotton, etc. (Sock/Fingering, 18-20 WPI "OR" Sport/Baby, 15-18 WPI).
6. Other Fiber, 100%: Dog, Camel, Goat, Angora, Yak, Cotton, etc. (DH/Light Worsted, 12-15 WPI "OR" Worsted/Aran, 10-12 WPI).
7. Blended Fiber: A Combination of 2 or more fibers, 100% (use same weights as above from #1,3, or 5).
8. Blended Fiber: A Combination of 2 or more fibers, 100% (use weights from #2, 4, or 6)
9. Novelty: Beaded, Insert, Unbalanced, Flubby, Yarn Bump, etc. (use weights from #1, 3, or 5)
10. Novelty: Beaded, Insert, Unbalanced, Flubby, Yarn Bump, etc. (use weights from #2, 4, or 6)

### Division Rules:

1. All skeins from a SPINNING WHEEL must be a minimum of 3 oz.
2. All skeins from a DROP SPINDLE must be a minimum of 2 oz.
3. All skeins must be wrapped in a 2-yard niddy noddy.
4. Novelty skeins must contain a minimum of 75% natural fiber.
5. Novelty skeins must identify method used (i.e. beaded, insert, unbalanced, etc.).
6. All skeins must include a sample square (minimum of 3" x 3") from the finished yarn (crochet, knit, woven, or knit raker).
7. All skeins must be tied gently with figure eight ties in four places.
8. Classes divided in multiple "weights". Insure you enter your skein in appropriate CLASS.
9. "Other Fiber" MUST list Fibers.

## Division F – Wool Spinning Finished Project

### Class No:

1. Knitted Article.
2. Crocheted Article.
3. Felted Article.
4. Woven Article.
5. Knit Raker Article.
6. Combination of two or more techniques.
7. Poster.
8. Handmade drop spindle.
9. Handmade niddy noddly.
10. Handmade lazy kate.
11. Any other handmade item not listed above used in or for wool spinning.
