#### Rules/Guidelines:

1. All exhibits made completely by exhibitor unless otherwise stated.
2. To facilitate hanging of bed quilts in quilt display, please attach 4" sleeve 80" or less from the bottom edge.
3. Attach the entry tag using painter's tape over the quilter's name.
4. **Only one entry allowed each exhibitor in each class number.**
5. Exhibit items to be picked up on Sunday between 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM
6. Size of bed quilts: Maximum 60"x80" or total area of 280 inches.
7. Size of lap quilts: Maximum 60"x80" or under 280 inches.
8. Baby quilt, crib size 36"x45" or equivalent inches.

3. Rag Quilt (any size).
4. Baby Quilt.

### Division Rules:

Lap Quilts and Bed Quilts Maximum Size: 60" x 80", or total area of 280 inches.

## Division E – Miscellaneous Quilts

### Class No:

1. Bed Quilt, 1<sup>st</sup> year exhibitor, any technique.
2. Bed Quilt, top made by 2 or more people.
3. Bed quilt made with antique top, completed by exhibitor.
4. Memory Quilt, featuring image transfer/memorabilia.
5. Doll Bed Quilt, any technique, 24" x 24" or smaller.
6. Miniature quilt, any technique, 24"x 24" or smaller.
7. Bed quilt, machine embroidery.
8. Quilt, creativity using printed fabric panels.
9. Any tied quilt.
10. Quilt by youth up to 18 years of age.
11. Any other wearable quilted item. Any sewn quilted wearable article. See Dept. 26 any patch work or quilted article.
12. Found quilt, top completed by exhibitor.
13. Fun \* Functional lap quilt for **Project Linus** \*.

### Division Rules:

PROJECT LINUS: All entries under the Project Linus listing will be donated through Project Linus. Please keep in mind when designing: all Project Linus lap robes are given to children ages 0-18 and need to be washable. For more information along with free pattern suggestions on Project Linus, visit [www.projectlinus.org](http://www.projectlinus.org).

- Additional info:
  - Must be a lap robe minimum of 36" x 36" and a maximum of 66" x 90"
  - Any method accepted. No adornments, buttons, loose ribbons, etc.

### Division Award:

**Special Award:** Dedicated to the promotion of the art of quilting. The "It's a Stitch Quilt Club" of Jackson, WI will sponsor a special award to a quilt and to a separate quilted item deemed that, while not a major award winner, has a quality to merit special recognition. The award consists of a special ribbon and \$10.00.

## Division F – Home Environment

### Class No:

1. Bedspread, knit or crocheted.
2. Any hooked or braided rug.
3. Any woven article.
4. Any item of Swedish weaving.
5. Pillowcases, any hand needlework, pair.
6. Pillowcases, machine embroidered, pair.
7. Pillowcases or pillow shams, sewn by exhibitor, pair.
8. Pillow, any type of needlework (cross stitched, embroidered, or smocked).
9. Pillow, pieced or appliqued.
10. Pillow, hooked.
11. Placemats, any type of needlework, set of 4.
12. Placemats, any type other than needlework, set of 4.
13. Table Runner, any hand needlework.
14. Table Runner, piecework.
15. Tablecloth, piece work, quilted, or appliqued.
16. Napkins, set of 4.
17. Hand Towels, set of 2.
18. Creative use of machine embroidery in any item.
19. Hot pads or oven mitts (2 minimum).
20. Wool applique item, need not be quilted.
21. Chair seat, woven or rushed or caned.
22. Refinished Furniture.

## Division G – Table Setting

### Class No: (For year 2025)

1. Saluting the Military.
2. Movie Theme.
3. Backyard BBQ.

### Division Rules:

Exhibitor must provide standard size card table with name on it. Each setting includes at least a tablecloth or placemat, napkin, plate, cup and saucer or glass/mug, silverware, a floral or decorative arrangement of original design.

Exhibitor must set table with only 1 place setting.

## Division H – Holiday

Class No:

1. Christmas tree skirt.
2. Christmas stocking, able to be filled and hung.
3. Christmas tree ornament.
4. Christmas card and envelope, original work, mounted.
5. Father Christmas or St. Nick.
6. Angel, any type.
7. Snowman, any type.
8. Door decoration, other than wreath.
9. Door decoration, any season other than above.
10. Outdoor decoration, any season other than above.
11. Indoor decoration, other than listed above.
12. Wall quilt, Christmas theme.
13. Wall quilt, Halloween theme.
14. Wall quilt, other than listed above.

## Division I – Wall Decorations

Class No:

1. Wall hanging, embroidered, crewel or candle wicking.
2. Wall hanging, needlepoint.
3. Wall hanging, counted cross stitch (14 count or larger stitches).
4. Wall hanging, counted cross stitch (16 count or smaller stitches).
5. Wall hanging, counted cross stitch on linen.
6. Wall quilt, pieced and quilted.
7. Wall quilt, appliqued and quilted.
8. Wall quilt, paper pieced and quilted.
9. Wall hanging, featuring machine embroidery.
10. Wall hanging, any hardanger.
11. Wall hanging, any other technique not listed above.
12. Wall hanging, any first-time exhibitor.

## Division J – Au Naturele

### Class No:

1. Molded Beeswax.
2. Fragrant Soap – 3 bars.
3. Work Soap/Laundry Soap – 3 bars.
4. Wheat weaving item.
5. Garden or yard decoration, painting on wood, molded figure, weathervane, whirl-i-gig, etc.
6. Garden or yard decoration other than wood – copper, metal, glass, potter, cement, etc.
7. Silk and/or dried flower arrangement.

### Division Rules:

All exhibits must be ready to hang.

## Division K – Wreaths

### Class No:

1. Wreath, any theme made with combination of natural and man-made materials (state theme).
2. Wreath, grapevine, made with combination of natural and man-made materials.
3. Wreath, occasion labeled on tag, made with all natural materials.
4. Door or wall swag, made from all natural materials.
5. Garland (At least 6ft long, string or chain of artificial foliage, flowers, etc. Christmas allowed).

## Division L – Creative Crafts

### Class No:

1. Garden or yard decoration.
2. Stuffed article for home décor.
3. Stenciled item.
4. Painting on wood.
5. Glass or pottery.
6. Metal article.
7. Thread painting.
8. Raw edge applique.
9. Any bought article or garment featuring machine or hand embroidery.
10. Decoupage item.
11. Quilled item.
12. Beaded item.
13. Metalwork article.
14. Display picture frame, shadow box.
15. Stained glass article.
16. Creative accessory for the home, not listed above.
17. Handmade paper (2 sheets at least 6" x 6").
18. Handmade Card & Envelope, mounted for Christmas.
19. Handmade Card & Envelope, mounted for an adult birthday.
20. Handmade Card & Envelope, mounted for a child birthday.
21. Handmade Card & Envelope, mounted for a wedding or anniversary.
22. Handmade Card & Envelope, mounted for any other occasion (label on tag).
23. Any 1<sup>st</sup> time card maker – envelope optional, state occasion.
24. Any bag or box decorated, no wider than 8".

Classes 21-25 must all be original work.
