3. Other rules and regulations set forth earlier in this book for the corresponding regular open divisions will also be in effect for the Senior Citizens Divisions.
4. All articles will be released on Sunday evening from 6:00 PM – 7:00 PM.

## Division A – Cultural Arts

#### Class No:

1. Watercolor.
2. Oil.
3. Acrylics.
4. Pencil Drawing (framed & ready for hanging).
5. Ceramics.
6. Jewelry.
7. Collective hobby.
8. Card & envelope or stationary made from recycled material, mounted on cardboard.
9. Creative writing (short stories) minimum 8 pages.
10. Genealogy (heritage & family trees).
11. Stenciled Item.
12. Quilled Item.
13. Decoupage Item.
14. Creative accessory for the home.
15. Stained glass item.
16. Any other craft not listed.

Division Rules:

All pictures (except stretched canvas art) must be framed and ready for display – Saw tooth or wire hanger for wall hanging or a frame with leg stand – Stretched canvas do not require a frame but DO require either a saw tooth or wire hanger.

## Division B – Woodworking

Class No:

1. An article for outdoors.
2. An article for the home.
3. A toy or homemade game.
4. An article of creative design from wood or wood and other material.
5. Bird house.
6. Bird feeder.
7. Wood carving – large, over 6”.
8. Wood carving – small, under 6”.
9. Repaired or refinished article.
10. Chair seat replacement (cane, rush, or woven.)
11. Creative Woodworking (scroll).

## Division C – Knitting

Class No:

1. Simple sweater.
2. Scarf, mittens, or hat.
3. Afghan (any knitted type).
4. Pillow.
5. Any other knitted article.

## Division D – Crocheting

### Class No:

1. Sweater.
2. Afghan, (crochet type).
3. Placemats or tablecloth.
4. Pillow.
5. Cap and mitten set.
6. Scarf.
7. Mitten pair.
8. Scarf and glove set or scarf and mitten set.
9. Any other crocheted item.
10. Large doily, mounted – over 9” diameter or length if oblong in shape.
11. Small doily, mounted – under 9” diameter or length if oblong in shape.

### Division Rules:

Sets cannot be divided and brought in separately. Additional entry classes have been added to accommodate “sets”, any single items that are a match and not entered as a set will either be marked down or disqualified.

## Division E – Quilting

### Class No:

1. Quilt – for baby.
2. Quilt – twin or larger – machine quilted.
3. Quilt – twin or larger – hand quilted.
4. Quilt – tied.
5. Quilt – hand quilted.
6. Any other quilted item.
7. Lap quilt – 36” x 72” or smaller.
8. Decorative wall decoration that is quilted.

## Division F – Home furnishings

### Class No:

1. Any other home furnishing article.
2. Item for home, made from recycled material (must list items used).
3. Mechanical item made from recycled materials (must list items used and if item is operable).
4. Decorative doll (not intended for a toy).
5. Stuffed animal.
6. Creative accessory for the home – may be wall hanging, wall plaque, rug stitchery – the design must be original (no kits).
7. Hooked – Pillow.
8. Hooked rug, all wool strips.
9. Hooked rug, yarn.
10. Braided rug.
11. Any loom woven article.
12. Any hand-woven article.

### Division Awards:

**Special Award:** Dedicated to the promotion of the art of quilting, the “It’s a Stitch Quilt Club” of Jackson, WI, will sponsor a Special Award to a quilt or quilted item deemed that, while not a major award winner, has the quality to merit special recognition. The award consists of a special ribbon and \$10.00

## Division G – Needlework

### Class No:

1. Article for home use – plastic canvas – 12” or under.
2. Article for home use – canvas – 12” or over.
3. Article for personal use - plastic canvas – 12” or under.
4. Article for personal use - plastic canvas – 12” or over.
5. Article for personal use – canvas – 12” or under.
6. Article for personal use – canvas – 12” or over.
7. Counted cross-stitch large, framed item, 8” or larger.
8. Counted cross-stitch small, framed item, 8” or smaller.
9. Counted cross-stitch stationary or card item.
10. Counted cross-stitch own design.

### Division Rules:

“Personal Use” refers to items such as belts, hairpieces, wallets, purses, jewelry boxes, etc.

Needlework is a generalized term meaning any form of cross-stitch, canvas work, tapestry, Petit point. Needlepoint is worked upon specialized type of stiff canvas that have openings at regular intervals. (Example: Plastic canvas).

## Division H – Baby Articles

### Class No:

1. Sweater.
2. Cap.
3. Booties.
4. Cap and bootie set.
5. Sweater set w/cap and/or booties (sweater and cap or sweater and booties or all three).
6. Afghan.
7. Other knitted/crocheted article of clothing.
8. Any other knitted/crocheted item.

### Division Rules:

Knitted or crocheted.

Sets cannot be divided and brought in separately. Additional entry classes must have been added to accommodate “sets”. Any single items that are a match and not entered as a set will either be marked down by a placing or disqualified.

## Division I – Embroidery

### Class No:

1. Pillowcases (2) – hand embroidered.
2. Pillowcases (2) – machine embroidered.
3. Tablecloth – hand embroidered.
4. Tablecloth - machine embroidered.
5. Any other article – hand embroidered.
6. Any other article - machine embroidered.

## Division J – Toys

### Class No:

1. Doll.
2. Miscellaneous Toy.

## Division K – Photography

### Class No:

1. Enlargements.
2. Living things, other than flowers (4 colored pictures).
3. Flowers (4 colored pictures).
4. Landscape (4 colored pictures).
5. Children (4 colored pictures).
6. Vacation (4 colored pictures, 1 line caption).
7. Black & White, any subject (4 pictures).

### Division Rules:

1. All photos must be taken by the exhibitor during the current exhibit year.
2. Photos in one entry must be mounted on one piece of white poster board measuring 11" x 14".
3. Each exhibit (unless otherwise noted) must consist of four photographs.
4. All photographs must be printed on photographic paper.
5. Digital pictures are acceptable but cannot be enhanced except for specific enhanced digital display.
6. Matting or frames will result in disqualification.
7. Only certain exhibits need a caption. If it does not ask for one, a caption is not needed.
8. You cannot exhibit the same photograph in more than one class or department.
9. Entry tags should be attached to the upper right-hand corner of the poster board.
