Judging: Friday immediately after the Open Class Show (8:30 AM)

Rules/Guidelines:

1. All Dairy animals must be brought in between 2 pm and 6 pm Tuesday.
2. Animals entered in a club as Junior entries must be tied or stalled in the dairy barn with their Clubs display.
3. Any animals entered by a Junior Exhibitor must be shown by that Exhibitor, unless they become unavailable to show due to health, injury, or other concern. Another Junior Exhibitor may show the animal after consultation and approval of the Superintendent.
4. The animal must be kept in the display area of the person entering the animal.
5. Exhibits must be Junior division animals only. Open division animals may not be mixed with Junior division.
6. Animals must be body clipped prior to coming to the Fair.
7. Straw and hay must be stored in overhang.
8. **Danish system of judging.**
9. Entries cannot be changed after entry deadline, June 10th. Superintendent decision will be final.
10. Refer to entry number below for all breeds.

Definitions:

1. A Spring Calf is one born between March 1, 2025 and May 31, 2025 (Spring Calves must have some identification).
2. A Winter Calf is one whose date of birth is between December 1, 2024 and February 28, 2025.
3. A Fall Calf is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2024 and November 30, 2024.
4. A Summer Yearling is one whose date of birth is between June 1, 2024 and August 31, 2024.
5. A Spring Yearling is one whose date of birth is between March 1, 2024 and May 31, 2024.
6. A Winter Yearling is one whose date of birth is between December 1, 2023 and May 31, 2024.
7. A Fall Yearling is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2023 and November 30, 2023.
8. A 2-Year-Old is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2022 and August 31, 2023. A 2 Year includes a Yearling which has freshened.
9. A 3-Year-Old is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2021 and August 31, 2022.
10. A 4-Year-Old is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2020 and August 31, 2021, or older.
11. A 5-Year-Old is one whose date of birth is before 2019.

Division I – Herdsmanship Award:

Class No:

1. Dairy (small clubs with nine or less animals)
2. Dairy (large clubs with ten or more animals)

Division Rules:

This entry is for CLUBS or CHAPTERS. An exhibitor should check with their club or chapter before the registration deadline to be sure they are entered.

An exhibitor does NOT need to list this division on their entry form.

Premiums will be awarded for keeping the animals on exhibit in neat appearance, the feed, straw, hay bales and boxes in the proper place and the walkways in the barn in good order and appearance. Any decorations erected including barn cards will be considered in the Judging. All decorations must be removed before any premiums are paid.

Division J – Dairy Showmanship (Danish)

Class No:

1. Beginners, 8-11 Years
2. Intermediate, 12-14 years
3. Senior, 15 years and over

Division Rules:

Judging will be done on an individual basis. Exhibitor must be dressed in all white. Hard tipped shoes are recommended. State Fair dairy exhibitors are required to be in showmanship.

Division K – Group Classes

Class No:

1. Produce of Dam; 2 females any age which are the offspring of same cow, can be shown by different exhibitors.
2. Dam & Daughter; Dam & 1 Offspring, can be shown by different exhibitors.
3. Exhibitor Herd; 3 animals of any age, any breed, all shown by the same Exhibitor.

Division Rules:

NO Premium awarded. Awards will be determined by Class Sponsor.

Application Forms and Permission Slips need to be returned by June 30th to the Name and Address listed on the application form. *The form can be found at the end of this Dept. packet.*

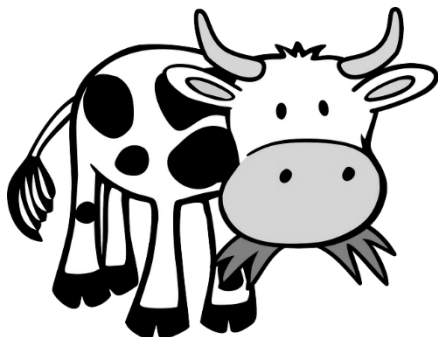

The Washington County Dairy Promotion Committee sponsors the Half Pint Showmanship Contest on **Sunday of the Fair at 1:00 PM** at the Washington County Fair Park Farm Progress Arena.

The contest is open to children 5-8 years old that are not yet old enough to have a livestock fair entry. Participants will use a calf born after January 1st of the current year. Prizes will be awarded to all participants.

Children/Parents/Guardians will be required to make arrangements to use one of the Junior or Open Dairy calves that are already at the Fairgrounds. Children will be divided into groups based on the participation level and at the discretion of the Dairy Superintendents.

Parents should come to the Farm Progress Arena **1 hour before** the contest to help set up the ring and walkway. There is also a **mandatory meeting 30 minutes before the event** start time. Back tags and programs will be handed out.
