# Division A – Horse/Horseless Horse Non-Animal Educational Exhibits

#### Class No:

- 1. Poster Safe habits to use when around horses.
- 2. Poster Diseases/parasites; causes, medications, and prevention.
- 3. Poster Flow chart Parasite Life Cycle, Disease staging, etc.
- 4. Poster Identify parts of saddle/bridle (English or Western)
- 5. Poster Identify equipment used for Western Pleasure riding.
- 6. Poster Identify equipment used for English Equitation
- 7. Poster Identify the parts of the horse.
- 8. Poster Display identifying parts of Horse Hoof Parts.

- 4. Second Item of equipment made by member for care of Beef Cattle [must be a different article than Class 3].

# Division F – Goats Non-Animal Education Exhibit

#### Class No:

- 1. Educational posters
- 2. Educational Exhibit other than poster. Examples: model, diorama, etc.
- 3. Item of equipment made by the member. Examples: milking stand, collar, leash, etc.

## **Division Rules:**

Posters must be exhibited on a 14" x 22" posterboard

# Division G – Poultry Non-Animal Educational Exhibits

# Class No:

- 1. Educational posters
- 2. Any educational display for care of poultry
- 3. Item of equipment for care of poultry
- 4. Second item of equipment for care of poultry
- 5. Decorated eggs 2 or more
- 6. Research and identify (4) birds with background of breed
- 7. Exhibit relating to poultry products (meat, eggs, etc.)
- 8. Any other educational exhibit not listed

- 5. Any forage/grain/feed for rabbits grown or processed by the exhibitor
- 6. Any item made by the exhibitor using rabbit products (meat, fur, etc.)
- 7. Any other educational exhibit not listed

#### Class No:

- 1. Educational posters
- 2. Educational Exhibit other than poster
- 3. Any other dog related article

# Division J – Llama/Alpaca Non-Animal Educational Costume Exhibit

#### Class No:

- 1. Educational poster on any Llama related topic.
- 2. Item of equipment made by the member and used for care or training of their Llama.
- 3. Item of equipment (different from Class #2) made by member and used foer the care or training of their Llama.
- 4. Any item made from 100% Llama fiber.
- 5. Any item made from 100% Llama fiber and different from Class #4.
- 6. Any other Llama related exhibit not listed above.
- 7. An educational poster documenting the steps taken to create the costume either from scratch or from recycled costumes or materials.
- 8. An educational poster documenting the steps taken to train the Llama to tolerate the wear and costume.
- 9. A scrapbook documenting the steps taken to create the costume.
- 10. A scrapbook documenting the steps taken to train the Llama to wear the costume.

## **Division Rules:**

This division (J #7,8,9 & 10) recognizes the work that it takes to create a costume for the Llama Costume Class. Members will bring their costume to the judging along with one or more of the items listed. The item(s) will be left to display in the Ziegler Family Building during the Fair, but the costumes will go with the member to be used during the costume class competition during Fair Week.

## Unit 1 Rules:

Only open to members enrolled in Veterinary Science Unit 1 "The Normal Animal" or doing equivalent work.

- 5. Poster or Chart relating to animal disease, bacteria and/or viruses.
- 6. Poster or Chart relating to external or internal parasites.
- 7. Poster or Chart relating to nutrition, stress, or heredity.
- 8. Any other exhibit not listed above.

#### Unit 2 Rules:

Only open to members enrolled in Veterinary Science Unit 2 "Animal Disease" or doing equivalent work.

# Unit 3

## Class No:

- 9. Poster or Chart relating to immunology.
- 10. Poster or Chart relating to zoonosis.
- 11. Poster or Chart relating to environmental or public health.
- 12. Any other exhibit not listed above.

# Unit 3 Rules:

Only open to members enrolled in Veterinary Science Unit 3 "Immunology, Zoonosis, and Health Immunology" or doing equivalent work.

## **Division Rules:**

Recommended poster size is 14" x 22", display board 18" x 22"; science board is acceptable.

# Division M – Pets

## Class No:

- 1. Any small pet.
- 2. A poster, report, scrapbook, or display on pet care health or nutrition.
- 3. A written report and picture researching breed information on your pet.
- 4. An educational display using photography or art to reflect your pet's personality.
- 5. Any other display.

# **Division Rules:**

Recommended poster size 14" x 22", display board 18" x 22"; science board acceptable
